Here is a piece of persuasive writing suggesting the point of view that school uniform is very important.

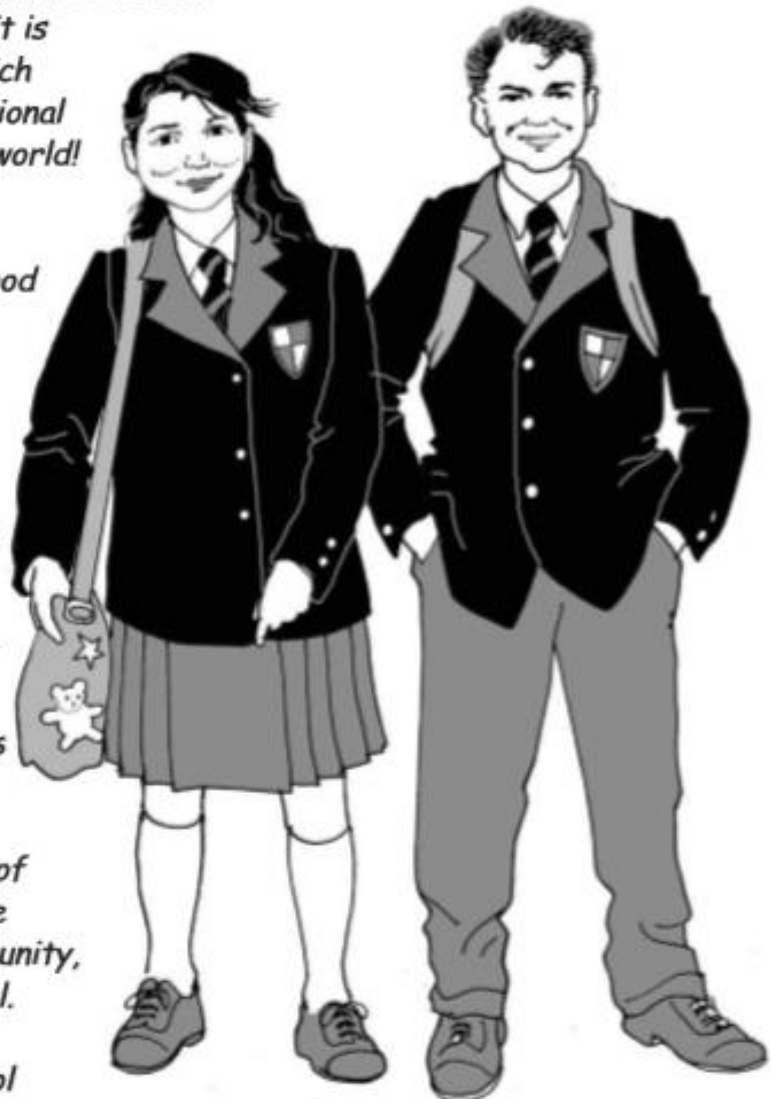
It is vital that we keep school uniform and maintain a tradition that has been in existence for years. It is traditions like these which make the British Educational system the envy of the world!

Whatever happens school uniform must stay!

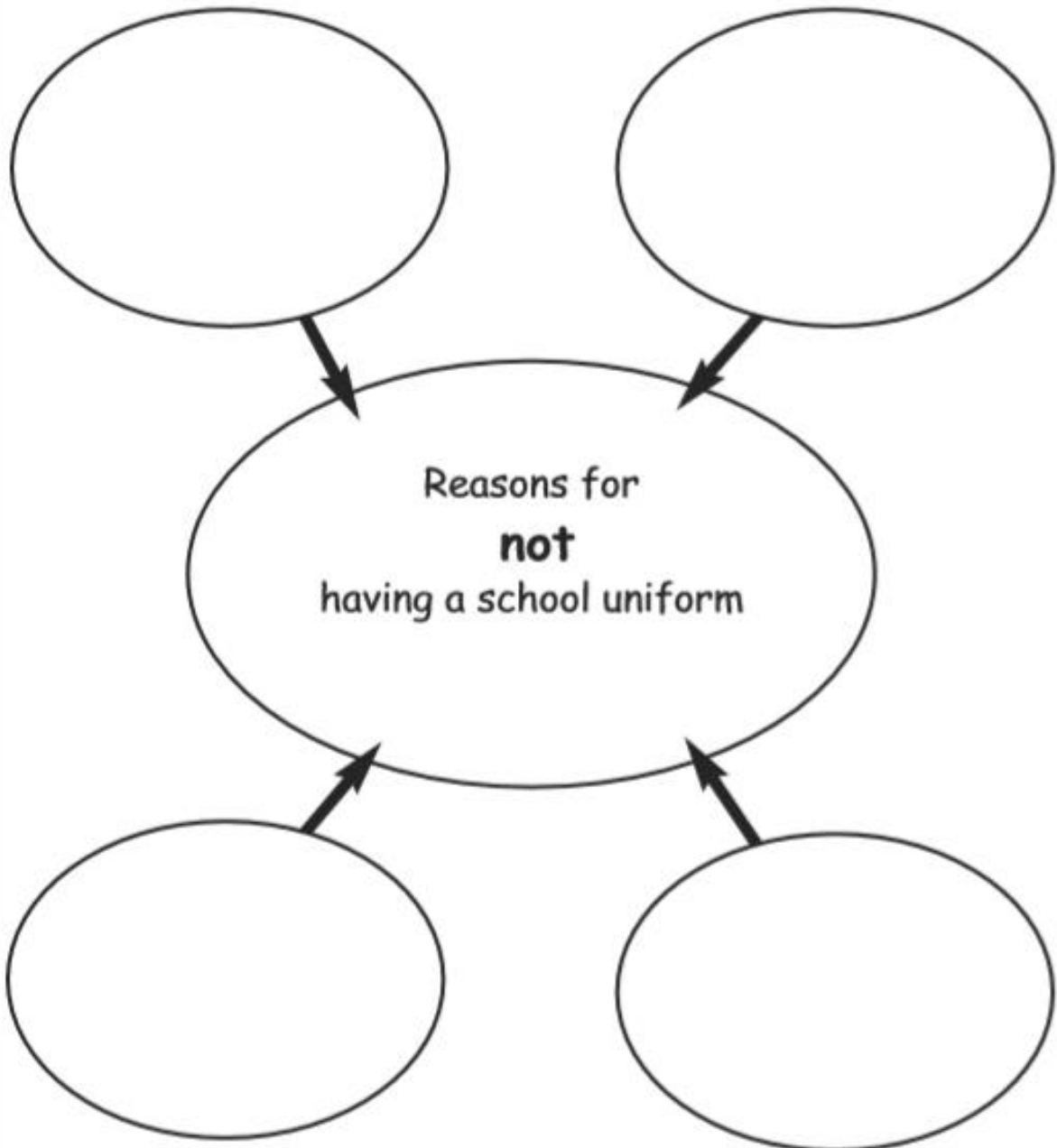




